Art

Visit an art museum, gallery or exhibit.

Discuss with an adult the art you saw.

- Memorial Hall was first used as an art exhibit hall during the 1876 World Fair!
- What kind of art do you see at Please Touch Museum?



Astronomy

Draw a diagram of our solar system.

Identify the planets and other objects.

- Where can you find models of the planets at Please Touch Museum? Take pictures and incorporate them with your own model!



Collecting

Visit a show or museum that displays different collections.

- What kind of objects can you find in display cases at Please Touch Museum?



Good Manners

Explain how treating things that belong to other people with respect is a part of having good manners.

Show three examples of how you can show respect for others.

- At PTM, did you have to share or take turns playing? What manners are important to remember while at a museum?



Map and Compass

Show how to orient a map.

Find three landmarks on the map.

- Using the Visitors Map of the Museum, find the exhibit zones. How many can you find?



Nutrition

Read the nutrition label from a packaged or canned food item. Learn about the importance of the nutrients listed. Explain what you learned to your den or family.

- What are the sections of the Food Plate? Grab a shopping cart at PTM's ShopRite Supermarket and fill it with an example of each nutritious item!



Photography

Using a camera, take at least 10 pictures of your family, pet or scenery; show these to your den.

- Take some pictures of your day at Please Touch Museum! With an adult's help, edit your photos at home or school.



Reading and Writing

Create a bookmark that you can use, or design a book cover. (*In the Program Room!*)

- Visit PTM's Story Castle for daily story times!
- At home, write a short story, letter or poem about your visit to Please Touch Museum- share with you den or family!



Science

Use simple machines to accomplish tasks: lever, pulley, wheel-and-axle, wedge, incline plan, and screw.
