

Make Your Own Drum

Things you will need:

- ✓ Plastic or metal container - the wider the better! It could be a margarine or yogurt container, baby formula or coffee can
- ✓ Packing tape or heavy-duty tape
- ✓ Construction or wrapping paper
- ✓ Stickers



Step-by-step instructions:

- 1. Decorate your container with paper and stickers, making sure to leave the top open.**
- 2. Cover the top completely with tape.**
- 3. Use your hands to test your drum!**

Try using pencils or markers as drumsticks and listen for a difference in sound.

You can find stickers on fresh fruits like apples, bananas and pears!
